3. A financial report of project period so far

Expenses specified on the different activities should clearly be demonstrated in the financial report of the project. This report should be signed a financial manager in charge of the project economy (bank account statements should not be attached).

Granted amount and financial report should be in NOK. The currency should be in accordance with the exchange rate of first workday after end of grant period.

Material cost and other cost may be requested to be reported in detail, especially if there is a large difference between budget and actual costs.

If the project shifted administrative body during the grant period, a formal financial final report from the original administrative body should be included.

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Activity report

a) Research:

Establishing an emailing list "Migra-Nord" that is open to all interested doctoral students and more senior academics. All activities are announced through the list and are open to application. So far the board has not had to select, but all those willing to participate have been accepted. Presently the list has 65 participants sharing information about research, publishing, training opportunities among themselves. The list was established in September 2007, and has grown steadily as the network has received more attention in the research community.

Launch of the network and workshop "Media and migration" coordination (with 11 network members presenting papers) at the Nordic migration research conference 13-16 November 2007 in Bergen.

Literature review of research in network scope: Horsti, Karina (2008). Overview of Nordic media research on immigration and ethnic relations: From text analysis to the study of production, use and reception. Forthcoming (accepted for publication in 2008) in Nordicom Review.

Research seminar "Avoiding the minority trap" 3-5.4.2008, University of Helsinki: Keynote speakers Terry Threadgold, Cardiff University, U.K. and Gavan Titley, NUIM, Ireland. Mixed seminar of both senior and junior (doctoral students included) researchers. Ongoing doctoral dissertations were also presented and discussed. 24 participants.

Six network members were invited to "Mediated networks" preconference organized and funded by University of Leeds, 19.7.2008, Stockholm. Karina Horsti and Rikke Andreassen presented study: "Overview of current Nordic research on mediated networks and migration: Case on Muslim women in the media's intersection of race, gender, sexuality and nationality"

The network was launched to international research community at IAMCR World Congress with a poster presentation "Nordic research on media, migration and ethnic relations", 20-25.7.2008 Stockholm. □

Nordic bibliography on media, migration and ethnic/ race relations was organised by the Network and launched on the website in July 2008. The bibliography will be updated annually. It includes 79 references in English, and more in Nordic languages, in addition direct links to online articles.

Focus on Denmark, Norway, Sweden, and Finland.

The network will be involved in a European COST application organised by Myria Georgiou, University of Leeds, deadline for the application in October 2008.

b) Research training:

All activities have been open to doctoral students. There were several student papers presented and discussed at the "Avoiding the minority trap" -seminar.

Doctoral course "Media, Migration and Transnational Relations" will be organised 30th of March to 3rd of April 2009. A successful application for additional funding from Nordforsk was prepared and the course planned within the Network.

c) Mobility:

Seminars and meetings have offered opportunities to build contacts. Next year the network will launch visiting scholar and mentoring students programs.

d) Scientific meetings:

Bergen, 13 November 2008: Network business meeting. 10 members were present.

Helsinki 5.4. 2008: Network business meeting. 21 members were present.
Stockholm 20.7.2008: Network business meeting. 7 members were present.
